Terms & Conditions of Sale

The Langaller Farm Auction Sale 20th September 2024

The Langaller Farm Auction Sale held on 20th September 2024 is subject to the following Conditions of Sale which form the basis of the contract between any Purchaser and Langaller Farm.

All Potential purchasers and their representatives at this sale are deemed to have read and fully understood these Terms and Conditions of Sale, prior to them attending and bidding on any lot offered on the day of sale.

Basis of Sale:

1. Prior to the sale day and by arrangement with Langaller Farm, all lots are open to any pre-sale, inspection, trial, and veterinary examination that may be required by any prospective purchasers.
2. On the day of sale all lots will be 'SOLD AS SEEN' with any faults or description being entirely at the risk of the purchaser.
3. On the day of sale all lots are sold with no warranty with all questions of description and condition being entirely at the risk of the Purchaser.
4. All lots will be sold in pounds (£s) sterling.
5. The hammer price of all lots will be subject to VAT at the current rate of 20%.

Payment:

1. The purchaser shall pay Langaller Farm in full, before the removal of any lot from their premises.
2. Payment may be made by cash, card or by bank transfer (BACS).

Catalogue Description and Basis of Sale:

1. Whilst the description given in the sales catalogue is deemed to be correct, Langaller Farm or its agents accept no responsibility for any misdescription that may arise.
2. The Auctioneer may amend or add to any catalogue description during a Sale, in which event any announcement by the Auctioneer takes precedence over any entry in the catalogue.
3. All potential Purchasers must satisfy themselves as to the accuracy of the description before making any purchases.

Purchasers Duties:

1. All Prospective Purchasers will be required to pre-register at the Sales Office and obtain a buyer's number. You will be asked for a form of identification that proves your present name and address such as a driving licence or a recent utility bill. If you do not bring this identification with you, registration may be refused.
2. Prospective Purchasers are advised to make close inspection of Lots to ensure they are satisfied and it is the sole responsibility of the Purchaser to ensure that they are satisfied with the condition of any Lot before bidding.
3. In addition, all Prospective Purchasers should check all paperwork including passports which can be checked in the Sales Office prior to purchase.

4. Any Purchaser must check the passport before removing the animal from Langaller Farm and must notify them or their agents on the day of the sale if there are any discrepancies.
5. Each Lot is sold under these Terms and Conditions of Sale, unless otherwise specified by the Auctioneer on the day. There is no term implied in any sale that any Lot is of merchantable quality or is fit for training or any particular purpose.
6. Purchasers are subject to any announcements that may be made from the Auctioneer's Rostrum and therefore it is the responsibility of all bidders to be in attendance at the commencement of the sale of a Lot to hear any such announcements.
7. It is the responsibility of the Purchaser to ensure that he is satisfied with the condition of any Lot before bidding.
8. After the fall of the hammer any Lot purchased is at the Purchaser's expense and risk.
9. Nothing in these conditions shall dis-entitle the owner or the Auctioneer as their agent from compelling a Purchaser to pay the price of any Lots purchased by them.

Conduct of the Sale:

1. The Auctioneer may at their absolute discretion:
 - a) Refuse to accept any bid or bidder, without giving any reason.
 - b) 2. Regulate the bidding as the Auctioneer sees fit.
 - c) 3. Arrange, consolidate, or withdraw any Lot.
 - d) 4. Cancel or postpone a Sale on account of bad weather or other supervening causes. In the event that the Sale is cancelled, moved, or rearranged then Langaller Farm or their agents shall not be liable to pay compensation to any prospective purchaser, bidder or any other party.
2. Langaller Farm reserves the right to bid through the Auctioneer who is acting as their agent.
3. No person shall retract bidding once made.
4. Langaller Farm shall have a lien on each Lot until full payment has been received.
5. No set off or reduction will, under any circumstances be allowed nor shall Langaller Farm be liable for any accident or default on their part or of any Purchaser.
6. There may be a reserve price for any Lot, and subject to such reserve price the highest bidder shall be the Purchaser. Should any dispute arise between two or more bidders then the Auctioneer shall forthwith adjudicate on the dispute and their decision shall be binding on all parties, or at the Auctioneers discretion, immediately re-offer the disputed Lot for sale.
7. The Purchaser shall immediately on the fall of the hammer inform the Auctioneer of their Buyers Number. Failure in this respect entitles the Auctioneer immediately to offer the Lot for re-sale and the original Purchaser shall be liable to make good any difference in price to the Vendor.
8. Any Purchaser bidding as agent for the principal shall be deemed to have bid on his own behalf as well as on behalf of his Principal and the highest bidder shall be personally liable along with the Principal to the Vendor.
9. All attendees at this sale, do so at their own risk

Liability of the Auctioneer:

1. The Auctioneer acts as agent of the Vendor and the Auctioneer gives no warranties of any kind to the Purchaser.
2. The Auctioneer does not accept liability for:
 - a) The description or pedigree of the horse given in the catalogue.
 - b) 2. The physical condition or performance of the horse sold.
 - c) 3. The payment of the price by the Purchaser.
 - d) 4. The return of any horse by the Purchaser to the vendor.

Delivery and Risk:

1. Each Lot, until sold, shall be at Langaller Farm's risk. From the fall of the hammer, the Lot shall shall become the Purchaser's risk, but in no case must they be removed from the premises until paid for.
3. Title in the horse shall not pass to the Purchaser until the Purchaser has made payment in full for the horse by means of cleared funds. Until payment in full by means of cleared funds is made, title shall remain with Langaller Farm.
3. The Purchaser shall not be entitled to take delivery of the horse until payment in full for the horse has been made.
4. Should the Purchaser fail to pay for a Lot within a reasonable period then such Lot may at any time be resold by Public Auction or by Private Treaty, and the deficiency (if any) resulting from such resale shall immediately be made good by the defaulting Purchaser.
5. Nothing herein contained shall preclude Langaller Farm from pursuing all legal remedies available to them, or either of them for the recovery of the Purchase Price from a defaulting Purchaser and all expenses commissions and damages resulting from such default.
6. A Lot purchased shall be removed from the Sales premises no later than 6pm on the day of purchase or by separate arrangement with Langaller Farm.

Safety:

1. Every person attending the Langaller Farm Auction Sale, whether before, during or after, shall be deemed to be there at their own risk and Langaller Farm and their agents exclude all liability in respect of any injury sustained by any of them or any loss or damage to property which may occur from any cause whatsoever, nothing in this sub condition shall be taken to exclude or restrict liability at law for death or personal injury to any person arising from any negligence.
2. The alleyways, exits and entrance to the sale ring must be kept clear at all times during the sale. Those areas pose a risk to members of the public and attention should be drawn to this fact.
3. Any person entering the penning area are at their own risk.
4. Please note some entries have NOT been haltered trained, Purchasers should make provision for the handling of such Lot's post sale.
5. Any person engaged to bring and take away a Lot shall do so at the cost and risk in all respects of the owner of such a Lot.

Rights:

1. Langaller Farm reserve the right to add, alter or otherwise modify these Conditions of Sale.

Mares

Lot 1 - Boylan's Jubilee Gift – 2012: 12hh by Blewins Gift of Liberty out of Shybont Catkin {Llanarth Alleycat}. Gift is very straight forward, easy breeder and has given me a colt foal in 2021, another colt in 2022, a filly by Barkway Earlybird in 2023, a filly by Landemann Snapdragonin 2024 and is in foal to Barkway Early Bird for 2025.

Lot 2 - Mrs Patrick-Campbell – 2013: By the lovely Langaller Starring Role out of Lucie Glitters. Little Miss Consistent this mare is. Foals regular and easy and every foal has been sold at weaning. Her first was by Sandy's Light, then she had a Keady Star, 2 by Newtown Pedro and is now in foal for 2025 to Kellythorpes Addiction. She is a very valuable paddock mare, never sick or sorry or any trouble in any way whatsoever. Available.

Lot 3 - Gilgalad Rohan – 2012: Traditional cob mare. She gave me a cob colt foal in 2023 and is in foal for to Woodvean Midnight Blue; due May 16th 2025.

Lot 4 - Langaller Leading Light - 2014: By Langaller Starring Role out of Chantry Clover Girl. Langaller Leading Light was a very consistent winner in the showing as a 3 year old winning many County shows and culminating in being Supreme In-Hand Champion at the National Hunter Show and qualifying for HOYS. She was carrying to Primitive Proposal at the time and foaled a stunning colt, Langaller Prime Example. She was then broken and enjoyed a few years under saddle, before giving me a colt foal by Castlegar Cool Fin in 2022 and a colt by Keady Star in 2024. She is now in foal to Langaller King's Manna; due May 3rd 2025.



Foals

Lot 5 - Bay colt - D.O.B. 02/06/2024: Langaller Midnight Sun x Kellythorpes Addiction. Special, special, special. Occasionally a foal is born and immediately announces his arrival and claims your attention from the start. This one deserves the very best of showing homes. Available to substantial offer.

Lot 6 - Coloured colt - D.O.B 27/07/2024: Ask Charlie x Keady Star. Such a striking colt born later in the season. A true superstar in the making. 2 half siblings have been sold to the USA to eventing homes.

Lot 7 - Bay filly - D.O.B. 11/07/2024: Something a little different! A bouncing bay Riding Pony filly to make 12.2hh. By Landemann Snapdragon out of a Ardenhall Mlssoni mare.

Lot 8 - Chestnut colt - D.O.B. 02/07/2024: By our own Barkway Earlybird out of the Deanhills Prince Regent mare. He has the pedigree to match his conformation to become a top drawer Show Pony.



Two Year Olds

Lot 9 - Chestnut/grey filly - D.O.B. 31/05/2022: Tawnmore BiBi x Castlegar Cool Fin. I know not a popular age but what a lineage to buy in to? Castlegar Cool Fin is really one of the most amazing producers of exemplary horses. Putting him over Tawnmore BiBi has given us the most beautiful filly who will go on to a super career under saddle before being a top level Show Hunter broodmare.

Lot 10 - Coloured filly - D.O.B 15/05/2022: Keady Star x Raapeti. Another filly with this amazing cross of Keady Star and a TB mare. She typically has the substance and glamour of Keady Star and the quality and forward thinking of the TB.

Lot 11 - Coloured gelding - D.O.B. 15/05/2022: Keady Star x Sallybog Jane. Keady Star x IDx TB mare. What's not to like? Add in his perfect markings and extremely loose, free movement he ticks so many boxes.

Lot 12 - Grey gelding - D.O B. 23/05/2022: Castlegar Cool Fin x Pomegranite. A classic TB x ID. Tall, well limbed, elegant and one that everyone says 'Wow, what is that?' A real head turner of a M/W hunter stamp. And grey to boot!

Lot 13 - Coloured gelding - D.O.B. 15/05/2022: Keady Star x Langaller Hattie's Pearl. Curiously from a mare that we bred many years ago, sold and then had her back home many years later. This is her last foal and what a cracker! Another Keady Star with great bone, loose movement and easy, trainable temperament.

Lot 14 - Coloured gelding - D.O.B. 06/06/2022: Keady Star x Assagart Queen's Speech, Keady Star x Kings Master. Yes, please! From a fairly lightweight mare, Keady Star has donated his incredible substance yet maintained the quality of the dam. I just know that someone will take this chap, and he will fulfil your dreams.

Lot 15 - Chestnut filly - D.O.B. 2022: Langaller Starring Role x Trenavey Euphinia. This tall and elegant filly really takes the eye and stands out from her compatriots. She should have a very bright future as either as show or a competition horse. The future is bright, the future is orange!!!



Three Year Olds

Lot 16 - Coloured filly - D.O.B. 02/05/2021: Keady Star x Chantry Clover Girl. This filly has the best of pedigrees. Keady Star obviously needs no introduction. Her dam qualified for HOYS 4 times, 3 siblings has also qualified, and she will almost definitely go there under saddle. As she is my own, she has had to give her stable for paying customers horses and so has only been very lightly shown to date. I am hoping to get her out a few times now before she is backed and starts the next chapter.

Lot 17 - Bay filly - D.O.B. 10/05/2021: Colbeach Night Light x Langaller Midnight Sun. What a combination of pedigree! Colbeach Nighthlight x Woodvean Midnight Blue. She will make a top Large Hack/ Small Riding Horse.

Lot 18 - Coloured filly - D.O.B. 12/06/2021: Keady Star x Daria. I was very privileged to have the German sports pony mare Daria on breeding loan. She has won countless show classes before retiring to the paddocks. This filly is the first I bred from her and by Keady Star. She is a real showstopper and will turn many heads in the show ring or in the competition circles.

Lot 19 - Bay filly - D.O.B. 12/05/2021: Catherston Liberator x Billy Buzz. A filly bred in the purple for sure. Billy Buzz successfully competed at Advanced BE, her sire reached Advanced status by winning 3 Intermediates on the bounce, before siring multiple Advanced and International competitors. Pedigrees like this rarely become available.

Lot 20 - Coloured filly - D.O.B. 21/05/2021: Primitive Proposal x Langaller Daylight. A rare if not unique coloured filly by Primitive Proposal. I think she is the only one. That alone makes her special but add in her good looks and typical PP movement and forward attitude then she really should be someone's next superstar.

Lot 21 - Grey gelding - D.O.B. 03/06/2021: Castlegar Cool Mist x Tawnmore Bibi. The eldest of Bi BI's offspring here. She was at the top of her game as a top H/W Show Hunter Broodmare, and Castlegar Cool Mist was the favourite of everyone who met him. From hunting to giving pony rides he was a very special and very much missed stallion.

Lot 22 - Bay/Brown gelding - D.O.B 15/03/2021: By Langaller Starring Role out of Trenavey Euphrasia {Weld}. Harry has been lightly and successfully shown at County and local level. He stands at 16.1+ and is equally suited to a ridden career as a show horse or an Eventer/Competition horse. He is very easy to do in all ways and very willing to please. Offered for his current owner who does not keep ridden horses.
